RECREATIONAL AND RELAXING RESPITE

The Hudson Milestones Respite Program provides many services under its umbrella including 1:1 In- Home, Community Inclusion, Individual Supports, Overnight Respite, Weekend Respite, and Youth Respite! Each program provides services and help to support our clients and their families. We are always looking to help support more individuals in their pursuit to be as independent as possible in the community! Weekend Respite continues to increase their monthly activities. In addition to the traditional Saturday activities, they have added Friday night activities that further ADL skills. Individual Supports allows for clients who live either on their own or with their family to receive support in maintaining their living space, attending doctor's appointments and local events. Overnight Respite allows our clients who live with their families to come and engage in recreational activities and is a mini staycation for our clients. Youth Respite is our only program for school aged children 5-20 years old where staff work with children 1:1 in their home and community with activities such as homework, snack prep, after school clubs. Each service in the Respite program focuses on enjoyment and recreation, come join us!
